Selkirk Fair Horse Show Rules and Regulations

Following the AQHA, and NISC Rules and Guidelines with the exception of the following:

1. The show will begin at 4pm on Friday and 8am on Saturday. Competitors are asked to be ready at the gate when the class is called. If you need a tack change please let the Gate person know or your class will proceed without delay.
2. Payment is due when entries are made at registration. Only Cash is accepted. Debit machine on site.
3. Registration will begin at 2:00pm and close at 9:00pm on Friday and open at 6:00am on Saturday.
4. **No refunds on scratches.**
5. All entries must be made at least 2 classes prior to the class being announced, once the show is underway.
6. The Show Secretary is not at liberty to give out class information regarding the amount of competitors in a class, who, etc. until the show is over.
7. All contestants under the age of 18 must wear a helmet with a strap for speed events.
8. Age categories as per program and participants may be required to show proof of age at the committee's request.
9. Age categories are as of January 1st of this current year. Lead line – 6 & under, Pee Wee – 8 & under, Junior – 13 & under, Intermediate – 14 - 17, Senior – 18 & over.
10. The Judges and timekeepers decision is final in all classes. Complaints must be forwarded to the Show Secretary in writing along with \$50.00 in order to be considered. Any direct confrontation or use of foul language with the judge or show committee members will result in the following:
 - a. Loss in prize money and points
 - b. Eviction from show ring, grounds for the rest of the show events and perhaps future years.
11. Facility and organizing body will not be responsible for accidents or loss of property that may occur on the grounds. Waiver must be signed at the time of registration.
12. No Cross entries will be allowed for Walk Trot classes and Lead Line entries with Loping classes.
13. Open Classes are open to all ages.
14. Rookie Reining – 2 hands are allowed even on a Senior Horse, 2 hands are allowed on a horse that has a shank bit. Set patterns will be posted.
15. Classes must have a minimum of 3 competitors to be held or they may be combined or cancelled. If a class is cancelled then competitors will be refunded at the end of the show.
16. Stake Classes pay out to third place and must have a minimum of 3 entries to proceed. The payout is 100% of the entry fees collected plus any added money. 1st 50%, 2nd 30%, 3rd 20%
17. Selkirk Fair Show High Point awards will be given to Pee Wee, Junior, Intermediate and Senior.
18. All classes are eligible for the Selkirk Fair Horse Show Hi- point awards. These classes are eligible for the NISC Hi- point awards: Showmanship, English Pleasure, English Equitation, Western Pleasure, Western Horsemanship, Rookie Reining, Barrels, Pole Bending, and Flag Race.
19. Points are awarded as follows: 1st-5pts, 2nd-4pts, 3rd-3pts, 4th-2pts, and 5th-1pt with 5 or more in a class. If less than 5 then points will be awarded accordingly.
20. This Show is affiliated with the NISC (North Interlake Show Circuit).
21. Dogs brought on the grounds must be on a leash.
22. Stallions must only be shown by a senior competitor.
23. No "Run-ins" for speed event – GATE CLOSED
24. Proper attire/footwear is required when exhibiting.
 - Western: Boots with a heel, western shirt, pants, hat or proper riding helmet.
 - English: English boots, jacket, riding britches and proper riding helmet.
25. This is a NAERIC sanctioned event.
